

## Power Plant Approval 23194-D02-2017

Yellow Lake Solar GP Corp. Ownership Transfer of Yellow Lake Solar Project	Proceeding 23194 Application 23194-A001

SunEEarth Alberta Solar Development Inc. (SunEEarth) pursuant to Approval 22422-D02-2017,<sup>1</sup> is the operator of the 19 megawatt solar power plant (Yellow Lake Solar Project) located near the village of Burdett.

SunEEarth, by Application 23194-A001 registered on December 12, 2017, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval of an ownership change for the power plant from SunEEarth to Yellow Lake Solar GP Corp.

The Commission, pursuant to Section 11 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 23194-D01-2017<sup>2</sup> and granted to Yellow Lake Solar GP Corp. an approval to own and operate the power plant, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The power plant shall be located in the northwest quarter of Section 13, Township 8, Range 12, west of the Fourth Meridian.
2. The power plant shall consist of approximately 83,125 solar photovoltaic panels, with a total generating capability of 19 megawatts, and continue to be in accordance with Application 22422-A001.
3. Yellow Lake Solar GP Corp. shall submit a progress report to the Commission in writing, once every six months, on construction progress pursuant to Section 3 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Regulation*. The first progress report shall be filed with the Commission six months from the date of issuance of Approval 22422-D02-2017.
4. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, construction of the power plant shall be completed by July 31, 2018.
5. Yellow Lake Solar GP Corp. shall notify the Commission within 30 days if completing the power plant.

6. Yellow Lake Solar GP Corp. shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any material changes to the power plant or substantially varying the design and/or specifications of the power plant from what was stated in the application or from what the Commission has approved.
7. Yellow Lake Solar GP Corp. shall comply with the current applicable reclamation standards at the time of decommissioning. If no legislative requirements pertaining to reclamation are in place at the time of decommissioning, the applicant will submit a reclamation plan to the Commission for approval.
8. This approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

Approval 22422-D02-2017 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this approval, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this approval, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
