Project Update

BluEarth Renewables is committed to engaging stakeholders on our projects and working together with honest and transparent communications. We are sending this newsletter to provide a community update on the development of our Yellow Lake and Burdett Solar Project located in the County of Forty Mile.

We are pleased to announce that construction will be begin on the Yellow Lake and Burdett Solar Project in late August of this year.

On July 28, we announced that BluEarth signed power purchase agreements (PPAs) with Bullfrog Power and the Royal Bank of Canada for the Yellow Lake and Burdett Solar Project. These PPAs will directly support the construction of this Project, which will be completed by PCL Construction Management Inc. The Project is expected to be operational in April 2021. See the reverse side for the construction schedule.

In addition, our Municipal Development Permit extension was approved by the County of Forty Mile in May 2020 and a Water Act Approval was issued by Alberta Environment & Parks in June 2020. The Project also received an amendment approval from the Alberta Utilities Commission in July 2020, which approves our chosen technology of modules and inverters.

The Yellow Lake and Burdett Solar Project has a nameplate capacity of 39 MW, and will generate enough energy to power up to 6,400 homes annually with clean, renewable energy. In addition, this Project will create up to 300 jobs during peak construction, and during operations will require a full-time local team of two solar technicians.

This Project will inject over \$70 million of capital investment into the Alberta economy, and will also provide indirect revenue to the local community in the form of local services and supplies, and municipal taxes.


